Treehouse Learning Community aims to provide consistent community and rich group experiences for homeschoolers. Home learning is enhanced and strengthened through circle time, math rhymes, rhythm games, songs, movement, cooperative games, nature walks, painting, fiber arts, and other chosen work. We prioritize time for students' social growth through child-led projects and child-directed play.

We meet on Tuesday and Thursday mornings - with one group for children ages 4-6 and one for children ages 6-9. We are considering adding a third group for 4-6 year olds on Wednesdays in Fall 2015.
